Position Description:

Our infant and toddler church members need supportive, open, and loving care while their parents and older siblings attend service and classes. Our youngest members need to feel safe to explore their burgeoning sense of wonder, joy, awe, and love of the world and beings around them. Church childcare workers will report to the Director of Religious Education (DRE) and be available during Sunday services in the Hewitt Hall childcare room to engage children under age 3 in play, art, and stories. There will always be two qualified workers present. The usual child participation during the school year averages around four to six children and varies each week.

Schedule commitment:

Childcare Workers provide care Sunday mornings, during the 11 am Sunday service, between 10:30am and 12:30pm. Additional hours are available for special events, family potlucks, concerts and other church sponsored events.

The successful applicant undertakes to support the principles and values of the Unitarian Church of Vancouver, and to adhere to the UCV's Covenant of Good Relations in their professional conduct, but is not required to adhere to any belief system, faith, creed, or religion. UCV is an inclusive liberal religious community of diverse beliefs and shared values--spiritual growth, social justice, environmental sustainability, artistic expression, and compassion. Preferred Qualifications:

Experience and knowledge of early childhood education preferred; care or teaching experience with babies and toddlers; Red Cross Babysitting class or high school diploma or equivalent combination of experience and training. An open-minded, respectful, approach to diverse beliefs and practices. Excellent communication skills. Caring, authentic, and engaging demeanor. The Childcare Worker will need to be able to complete first aid training and pass a police record check for working with children as a condition of employment. Expenses will be covered by the church.
