September COVID-19 Updates

We have released our Fall 2020 Go-Slowly-Forward Plan. Notable changes include:

- We have increased rental capacity for the Hewett Centre (main hall area only) from 10 to 15 guests
- The Sanctuary is now available for rentals with a maximum of 25 guests and 5 staff choir loft remains Staff Only
- Masks are now mandatory for all indoor activities
- All windows and doors MUST remain open during indoor activities

OUTREACH OPPORTUNITIES FUND: Our OOF recipient (June-Sept 2020), is the Burns Bog Conservation Foundation, which was set up in 2002 as an endowment fund for the Burns Bog Conservation Society. Burns Bog is a globally unique ecosystem functioning as a major regulator of regional climate and as the "the Lungs of the Lower Mainland". Endowment funds are also to be used for research relating to peatlands/wetlands and the development of an Education Centre.
