
Artist Trading Cards A

People all over the world are making Artist Trading Cards (ATCs) and trading them with each other. They are easy to make with art supplies you probably already have at home.

Here is the exact size: 2.5 x 3.5 inches, or 7 x 9 cm.

You can make them from any strong, flat material like cardboard product boxes, like cracker boxes, cereal boxes, tissue boxes, frozen pizza boxes, etc.

You can decorate them with: pens, pencils, felt pens, acrylic paint and watercolours.

You can make a "collage" by cutting up and gluing torn or cut up papers, like magazines or junk mail.

You can stitch through or cut slits and weave things through your ATC, too.

<u>FRONT</u>: Put your artwork, using whatever materials and style you like.

BACK: The title of your artwork, the date you made it. If it's part of a set you can add: Card #1 of 3, for example. Also add: your first name (you can add your last name, your age and the city you live in, but only if it's okay with your grownups).
