Head Counselors act as Hogwarts professors and Heads of House. They lead classes in an interactive theatre experience within the Harry Potter theme focused on social action. Head Counselors may focus on their area of expertise for each section. The DA Explorers, ages 7+, take Hogwarts classes exploring the magic of water, learn theatre games, and play within the Hogwarts theme. The DA Creators take advanced classes in water magic, script writing, and interactive theatre. DA Creators create Friday's interactive performance for family and friends. Camp dates are August 12-16 with 3 days of training and preparation in the preceding week and 1 day of clean-up to follow.
