

PIVOT LEGAL SOCIETY

Starting July 3, our OOF recipient will be **Pivot Legal Society**. Established in 2001, Pivot has worked in partnership with marginalized people and grassroots organizations to challenge legislation, policies, and practices that undermine human rights, intensify poverty, and perpetuate stigma. It has accomplished lasting changes that have resonated across the country, including protecting the constitutional rights of sex workers, working with vulnerable people who use drugs to breakdown legal barriers to lifesaving harm reduction and drug substitution treatments, supporting victims of police misconduct and excessive force and helping homeless people secure important legal decisions confirming their rights.
